Patient will be discharged with a POP backslab to stay insitu for 10-14 days. Patient will be mobilising on crutches non-weight bearing.

|                      | Proprioception  |
|                      | Peroneal strengthening  |
| NOTE:                | Patient is to remain in the ROM boot at all times and can begin to weight bear.                         |
| 12 weeks post-op –   | Patient appointment at Dr. Hazratwala's private rooms   |
|                      | Commence use of normal shoes  |
|                      | Commence to full activities   |
